Club Incorporation

Some clubs have indicated that they are not incorporated. If your club is not incorporated, I suggest you strongly consider incorporating and contact Kiwanis International to learn how to proceed. I copied the following from the Kiwanis website:

Division Goals

- •12% Net Membership Gain Minimum
- •10% Increase in service hours over last year
- •Rebuild two small clubs
- ·Have fun as we meet and serve

Reason for incorporating. When a club is unincorporated, anyone holding a claim against the club can proceed against the assets of the individual member if the club has insufficient funds to meet its obligations. When a club incorporates any creditors have recourse only to the funds or property of the incorporated club, and cannot proceed against the individual members of the club. Actually, incorporation constitutes an inexpensive form of insurance.

Reading for Diversity - First Lady, Betty's Initiative

Election Reports

Division 5 Contribution of \$2.00 per Member

Please remember that the Division Council at its January meeting voted unanimously to support this asking from each club. The purpose is to help support the work of the Division and to help keep down the cost to members, of our two major functions of the year; the Governor's Visit and the Prayer Dinner. Had we not been able to use Division discretionary funds to cover some of the costs, these two functions would have been much costlier to members attending. We are also trying to get into a position where the Lt. Governors can be reimbursed for more of their expenses in the future. It is too much to expect a Lt.
